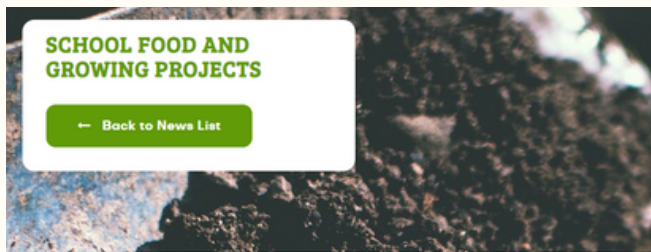


Supporting the Good Food Local North East pilot
